Hannaher named new Director of Philanthropy at LSSND

Long-time Fargo businessman joins statewide social ministry

FARGO, ND (Wednesday, May 2, 2018) – Dan Hannaher, a long-time business owner and active community member, has been named the new Director of Philanthropy at Lutheran Social Services of North Dakota.

Hannaher spent more than 20 years as the president and CEO of Hannahers, Inc., a family-run office-furniture supplier. In 2009, he was named the Regional Administrator for the U.S. Small Business Administration out of Denver, overseeing the work of hundreds of federal employees stationed across a six-state region. In 2014, Hannaher joined Sanford Health as Senior Legislative Affairs Specialist in the Office of Public Policy. Additionally, he served as director of the Health Policy Consortium.

Hannaher has been active in the Fargo-Moorhead community throughout his career, serving on the Fargo-Moorhead Symphony Board of Trustees, North Dakota Hospital Association, The Chamber of Fargo, Moorhead and West Fargo, the United Nations Foundation, the US Global Leadership Campaign, the Village Family Service Center Board, MSUM Alumni Foundation Board and Fargo Public Library Board of Trustees.
